






The 81-cabin *National Geographic Explorer* is the quintessential expedition vessel, equally at home on the high seas or in the small harbors of Europe. Our new, state-of-the-art sister ships *National Geographic Endurance* and *National Geographic Resolution* each feature 76 cabins, sleek Scandinavian design, and special amenities such as infinity hot tubs and twin saunas.

In the Mediterranean, we travel aboard elegant tall ships from the Sea Cloud fleet—traditional windjammers that harken back to the Golden Age of Sail. Whether you board the historic, 30-cabin *Sea Cloud* or her modern counterpart, the 44-cabin *Sea Cloud II*, you will experience all the glamor and thrill of traveling under billowing sail. But the authentic heart of Iceland lies in its remote landscapes, its rugged interior, and its hard-to-reach coastal gems—and exploring by expedition ship is the perfect way to venture deep into the country's most secluded corners.

Cruise by Zodiac to the base of thundering waterfalls. Sail from the open ocean into towering fjords and watch them narrow as you approach volcanic beaches. Go ashore in small towns and villages that were only accessible by water up until the late 20th century. Nicholas Kristof

In 2025, we are thrilled to welcome acclaimed journalist Nicholas Kristof to the National Geographic Endurance as a special guest speaker on the April 2 departure of Islands of the Azores: Basalt Peaks to Volcanic Vineyards.

Two-time Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist Nicholas Kristof has contributed to *The New York Times* for nearly four decades—as a reporter and a columnist—covering topics ranging from presidential politics to human rights issues. Early in his career, Kristof backpacked through Africa and Asia, writing articles to fund his travels. He has lived on four continents, reported on six, and visited more than 150 countries. During his adventures, he survived malaria, encounters with wars and warlords, and an airplane crash, among other adversities.

After joining *The New York Times* in 1984, Kristof served as a correspondent in Los Angeles, Hong Kong, Beijing, and Tokyo. He has interviewed everyone from President Obama to Iranian President Ahmadinejad, and he was the first blogger on *The New York Times* website.

In 1990, Kristof and his wife, Sheryl WuDunn—then also a journalist for *The New York Times*—became the first husband-wife team to win a Pulitzer Prize for journalism for their coverage of China’s Tiananmen

Square democracy movement. Kristof won his second Pulitzer in 2006 for what the judges called “his graphic, deeply reported columns that, at personal risk, focused attention on genocide in Darfur and that gave voice to the voiceless in other parts of the world.”

Together, Kristof and WuDunn have written five best-selling books, including *Half the Sky* and *A Path Appears*, each of which inspired a prime-time PBS documentary series. Kristof has won innumerable awards, including the Dayton Literary Peace Prize, the Anne Frank Award, and the Fred Cuny Award for Prevention of Armed Conflict.

As a speaker, Kristof captivates with his moving storytelling and unique insights into the events that shape our world. On our voyage through the Azores, he will share lessons learned from his decades of reporting, as well as thoughts on the philanthropy revolution—a movement that extends to sustainability initiatives. As a leading destination in sustainable tourism, the Azores provides a fascinating backdrop for discussions with Kristof on how conservation is tied to human rights and social justice.



Mary Robinson


Mary Robinson is one of the world's most respected advocates for climate justice. Her new book, *Climate Justice*, has received praise from former world leaders and the environmental and human rights community.

Robinson is a graduate of Trinity College and Harvard Law School. She holds honorary doctorates from more than 40 of the world's most elite universities and is the recipient of the Indira Gandhi and Sydney Peace Prizes. Robinson served in the Irish Senate for 20 years before ascending to the Presidency in 1990. She is widely regarded as a groundbreaking leader who helped shape modern Ireland in a period of rapid economic growth.

In 2007, Robinson became a founding member of The Elders, an independent group of global leaders formed by Nelson Mandela to tackle the world's most pressing issues. She was appointed as the UN special envoy on climate change in 2016 and has sounded the alarm when extreme weather events have disproportionately affected the world's most vulnerable populations.

Robinson is looking forward to returning to the Lindblad Expeditions-National Geographic fleet as a guest speaker on the Ireland portion of our journey. She brings the thoughtful leadership of a former head of state, a grandmother's passionately felt concern for the future, and the compelling stories of the thousands she has met traveling the world as a champion for climate justice and human rights. Among our travelers, she is known for sparking meaningful conversations and framing climate issues in solvable terms, leaving guests hopeful and inspired to change the course of our planet's future.
